SMSA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DEADLINE

The deadline is fast approaching to apply for a scholarship from the Seabee Memorial Scholarship Association (SMSA). Applications for the 2021-2022 academic year can be found on our website, www.seabee.org and will be accepted through April 15th. Scholarships from the SMSA are available to the children and grandchildren of Seabees, Civil Engineer Corps Officers and those who served or are serving with a Naval Construction Force Unit. Applicants must be a senior in high school or currently enrolled in an accredited university or college.

SMSA offers scholarships for four-year bachelor's degrees, two-year associates degrees or Career & Technical Education (CTE) degrees. Scholarships may be used for tuition, textbooks and academic-related fees and are renewable for up to four years.

The following items will be required to submit an application:

- DD-214, discharge or reenlistment certificates or active-duty orders for the Seabee Sponsor
- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application
- Signed IRS Form 1040 (page 1 & 2 only)
- Summary of extracurricular activities and awards
- Summary of applicant employment history
- High school or college transcript
- Personal statement essay describing future objectives, goals and connection to the Seabee sponsor



Applications will be evaluated by the Selection Committee in May and recipients will be notified in June.

There are currently 105 scholarship recipients studying at 78 colleges and universities in 36 different states. SMSA Scholarship Director Keith Hamilton says "I am always impressed at the quality and strength of our applicants and it's a real honor to be able to help so many achieve their college aspirations. I strongly encourage all eligible students to apply."

Applications can be started online any time before the deadline and saved. It's advisable to begin as soon as possible. Please address any questions to Mrs. Beth Reuning at 703-690-7672 or smsa@seabee.org.

FROM THE SMSA CHAIR'S DESK



Folks,

I hope everyone is doing well. For SMSA, we have been moving ahead at full steam! Though our donations are down, our endowment has grown due to a strong market. We all know the market will not last and was a bit of an anomaly. So, please continue with your generous donations! The message this quarter is scholarships! Please note that scholarship applications are due on the 15th of April. If you know of any children or grandchildren of Seabees, please get them to apply!

In response to COVID, knowing that many of our scholars and their families were under stress, we added a one-time \$500 boost per scholarship. Additionally, we reached back to our scholarship packages not awarded and selected 10 students to receive a one-time \$4,100 scholarship.

While we're talking about our scholars, here's some great data:

STEM - 67% of current SMSA Scholarship recipients major in one of the STEM Disciplines. (Class of 2021-2024) The National average is 16% of all Bachelor's Degrees awarded are in a STEM Discipline.

Engineering - 20% of current SMSA Scholarship recipients major in Engineering. (All types of Engineering, Class of 2021-2024.) The National Average is 6% of all Bachelor's Degrees awarded are in Engineering.

Graduation Rate - Since 1989 82% of our students graduated in four years, more than double the four year average of 41%.

First Generation College Student - Since 2015 28% of SMSA scholarship recipients are first generation college students.

We will continue with our local golf tournaments, and once we clear the pandemic hope to have many more fundraising and exposure events!

Keep charging and remember - it's ALL about the Seabees!

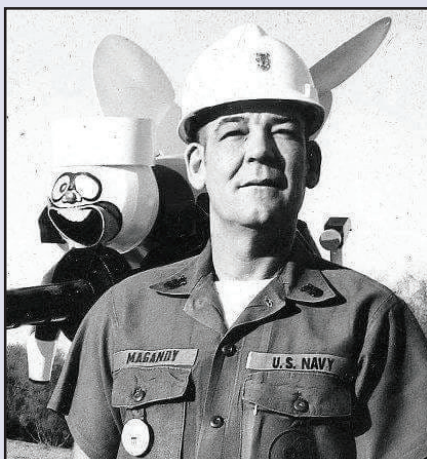
THE HUNTER WHARTON/I.U.O.E. PERPETUAL GENERAL NAMED SCHOLARSHIP

Established in 1978 by the International Union of Operating Engineers (I.U.O.E.) Mr. Wharton was National President of the I.U.O.E. from 1962 until 1976. His desire to memorialize the thousands of I.U.O.E. members who served in the Seabees led to the establishment of the Hunter P. Wharton/I.U.O.E. Scholarship. He was also one of the founding directors of the Seabee Memorial Scholarship Association (SMSA). His enthusiasm, generosity and support were instrumental in establishing the SMSA. Founded in 1896, IUOE today has approximately 400,000 members in 123 local unions throughout the United States and Canada. IUOE is the 10th largest union in the AFL-CIO. The union's headquarters is in Washington, D. C.



THE RADM ROY L. DUNLAP, CEC, USNR (Ret) PERPETUAL GENERAL NAMED SCHOLARSHIP

Established in 1982 by the staff who supported Rear Admiral Dunlap during his assignment as Commander, Reserve Naval Construction Force/First Reserve Naval Construction Brigade from October 1981 through September 1983. Rear Admiral Dunlap began his military career in 1945 as a Marine private. He was commissioned Ensign, Civil Engineer Corps in 1952 and subsequently held various billets in the Reserve Seabee Program. In April 1968, with then-Commander Dunlap serving as its Commanding Officer, Reserve Naval Mobile Construction Battalion-22 was recalled to active duty. In June, 1979 he was promoted to Rear Admiral and he retired on 30 September 1983 having served as Commander, Reserve Naval Construction Force. The members of the RMCB 22 Association increased the funding to the current level. RADM Dunlap passed away in 2015.



THE UCM JOHN W. MAGANDY PERPETUAL GENERAL NAMED SCHOLARSHIP

Established in 2008 by the family of John Magandy. Mr. Magandy retired as a master chief from the U.S. Navy after 30 years of service as a construction electrician in the Seabees. John joined the Navy in 1952 and served in Vietnam, Argentina, Newfoundland, Davisville, Virginia Beach and Gulfport. Magandy attained the position of Master Chief of the Atlantic Fleet Seabees, serving in that capacity before returning to Gulfport and NCTC. The hallmark of his career was working with the troops and serving as a teacher and mentor. He also served 16 years in government service with the 20th Naval Construction Regiment as a training officer. He passed away in 1998.

DONOR PROFILES

DR. ARLENE GARINGO



Arlene D. Garingo, MD, is the daughter of MSC Amor Garingo, USN (Ret), of San Diego, California, who served with NMCB 1. Dr. Garingo is a former scholarship recipient and was named the SMSA Distinguished Scholar in 2017. She is a graduate of the University of California, San Diego, University of California, Los Angeles and the University of California, Davis Medical School. She is Attending Neonatologist and Clinical Associate Professor of Pediatrics (Clinician Educator), Keck School of Medicine of USC. Dr. Garingo supports the “SMSA Past Recipients Scholarship” with her donations. The “Past Recipients Scholarship is being funded by former recipients to support other Seabee children and grandchildren.

MASTER CHIEF HANK BARSTOW



Master Chief Hank Barstow and his wife Tess have supported the SMSA for over 35 years. Hank bought his first Seabee calendar in 1982 and has been part of the Northeast Seabee Golf Tournament committee since the beginning. Hank served for 28 years in the Navy with NMCB 62, NMCB 3, NMCB 27, and the 7th regiment and retired as command master chief for Reserve Naval Construction Force Support Command. Hank- says “I believe in the mission of the SMSA and enjoy being part of the Northeast Seabee Golf Committee. I encourage all current and former Seabees to join me in this important cause.”

GRAHL FAMILY TRUST

In 2018 the Grahl Family Trust made a major planned gift to the SMSA. The trust was formed by CAPT Ralph G. Grahl and Dorothy L. Grahl to make charitable contributions upon their deaths. CAPT Grahl was the Commanding Officer, Navy Public Works Center, San Diego from 1970 to 1972. CAPT Grahl had a long and distinguished career with the Navy, including serving as Commanding Officer Eastern Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command and Public Works officer, Da Nang Province in Vietnam. Dorothy died in 2014 and CAPT Grahl died in 2017. In addition to the SMSA, the Grahls supported other organizations they cared about with generous gifts.

Ralph and Dorothy also created the Grahl Designated Memorial Fund at the San Diego Community Foundation to fund the causes they cared about in perpetuity. The Grahl’s generosity will provide support for Seabee Scholars for generations!

NOW IS A GREAT TIME TO DONATE APPRECIATED STOCK

With the rapidly changing economy and changes in the deductibility of cash gifts, donating appreciated stock may be a great strategy for some donors. The market is currently high and many stocks are at all time high values.

When you purchase stock and hold it for years it may go up significantly in value. This is good for your investment, but when you sell the stock, you may be liable for taxes on the difference of what you paid and what the stock is worth now. If this is the case, donating the stock to a 501c3 charity may be a good strategy for you. By donating the stock at its current value, you may be able to deduct the full value without having to pay taxes on the growth. Of course, consult your tax advisor or attorney before making any large donation to see if it will benefit you and your unique situation.

Donating appreciated stock to the SMSA is easy. Do not sell it yourself, simply have your broker transfer it directly to our brokerage account and we will handle the sale and provide you with a letter stating the value of your donation.

Opportunities for Funding Perpetual Scholarships

Perpetual Honor Scholarship

Funded at \$150,000 and payable over five years or less.

A Perpetual Honor Scholarship will provide for an annual scholarship to be awarded in perpetuity to the top student for each application pool. The value of each scholarship will be \$1,500/year higher than that established for Perpetual General Named Scholarships, and will be awarded for four years to the most deserving student(s) each year.

Perpetual Individual Named Scholarship

Funded at \$120,000 and payable over five years or less.

A Perpetual General Named Scholarship will provide for an annual scholarship in perpetuity for a four-year, two-year or Career and Technical Education (CTE) scholarship as the donor designates. As of 2019 the annual scholarship award amount is \$3,500 per year.

Perpetual General Named Scholarship

Funded at \$60,000 and payable over five years or less.

A perpetual Shared Named Scholarship will provide for an annual scholarship in perpetuity for a four-year, two-year or Career and Technical Education (CTE) scholarship as you designate. Other scholarship funds will also be awarded to the same student to fully fund the annual scholarship. As of 2019 the annual scholarship award amount is \$3,500 per year.
